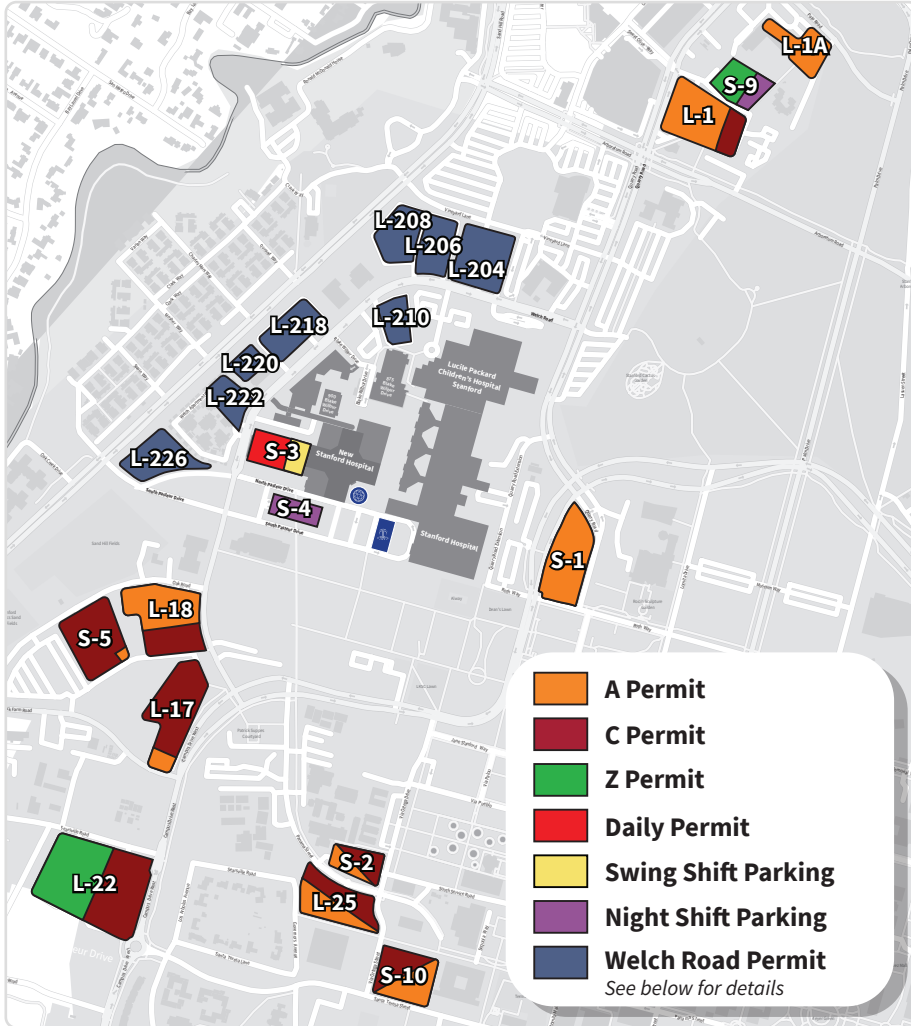

Free Parking Options

On July 6, 2020, two new Park and Ride locations will provide free staff parking in Newark and Menlo Park.

- Fircrest Park and Ride lot in Newark will provide free parking and shuttle service to the Ardenwood Park and Ride, where staff can connect with Marguerite Line AE-F or AC Transit Line U. To learn more and request a free Newark park and ride permit, click [HERE](#).
- SRI Park and Ride lot in Menlo Park will provide free parking and shuttle service directly to 500 Pasteur and Lucile Packard Children's Hospital Main. To learn more and request a free Menlo Park park and ride permit, click [HERE](#).

Staff Parking Enforcement

Stanford University will resume parking charges and enforcement in commuter parking areas on campus on **Wednesday, July 1, 2020**. Z parking permits, which have been available at no cost since April, will be returning to the standard cost of \$35 per month. For staff eligible to purchase A and C permits (SHC hire date before May 2013), A permits will be available at the standard cost of \$116 per month, and C permits will be available at the standard cost of \$35 per month.

Purchasing a Permit

A, C, and Z parking permits can be purchased on the Stanford University Transportation website at <https://transportation.stanford.edu/parking/purchase-a-parking-permit> beginning Monday, June 22. Please note: Only staff hired before May 2013 are eligible to purchase A or C permits



For additional flexibility, staff can purchase an \$8 daily parking permit at the 500P Pasteur Staff Garage through the Passport Parking app.

Daily Permits for the Pasteur Staff Garage (PSG) can be purchased through the Passport Parking app:

1. Download the Passport Parking App, create an account
2. Enter zone number 1650 for Pasteur Staff Garage
3. Pay for parking
4. Show proof of purchase on the app or a printed receipt to the parking enforcement stationed at the entrance of the garage.

Swing Shift staff may park for free in the Pasteur Staff Garage with a Swing Shift permit after 1 PM. Apply for a Swing Shift Hangtag Permit at <https://bit.ly/2QPIMXq>



Night Shift staff may park for free in Hoover Pavilion Garage (underground) or Pasteur Visitor Garage (LL4) with badge access between 4pm - 6am. Apply for Night Shift Badge Access at <https://bit.ly/2Rr32Qd>
