NEW Shuttle Schedule Updates -Santa Clara & Campbell Park & Ride Programs

The new shuttle schedule updates for the Campbell and Santa Clara Park & Ride will be effective Monday, February 19, 2024.



The Santa Clara and Campbell Park & Ride programs are convenient options for South Bay commuters heading to the Stanford Medicine Palo Alto campus.

Effective Monday, February 19, 2024, there will be shuttle schedule updates for the Campbell and Santa Clara Park & Ride programs.

Santa Clara Park & Ride

• The Santa Clara Park & Ride lot is located at 2945 Tasman Drive, Santa Clara, CA (near Levi's Stadium). The shuttle provides a direct connection from the lot to Lucile Packard Children's Hospital and 500 Pasteur.

- The Santa Clara shuttle operates during peak morning and afternoon/evening commuting hours, with morning trips leaving Santa Clara between 4:20 AM - 8:20 AM, and evening trips leaving the Stanford Medicine Palo Alto campus between 2:30 PM - 8:25 PM.
- Effective Monday, February 19, 2024, certain arrival times will be adjusted. Please see updated schedule below.

- The Campbell Park & Ride lot is located at 600 E. Hamilton Ave, Campbell, CA - conveniently located off of Highway 17. The shuttle provides a direct connection from the lot to Lucile Packard Children's Hospital and 500 Pasteur.
- The Campbell shuttle operates during peak morning and afternoon/evening commuting hours, with morning trips leaving Campbell between 5:10 AM - 8:20 AM, and evening trips leaving the Stanford Medicine Palo Alto campus between 2:30 PM - 7:30 PM.
- **Effective Monday, February 19, 2024,** the Campbell AM shuttles will now stop at 500 Pasteur before Lucile Packard Children's hospital. Certain arrival times will also be adjusted.

Enjoy easy, free parking and a direct shuttle ride that connects directly to Lucile Packard Children's Hospital and 500 Pasteur!

Commuting from the East Bay?

East Bay staff can park for free at the Ardenwood Park & Ride lot (Ardenwood Blvd. & Hwy. 84), which is located in Fremont. This lot connects with transbay commuter busses to the Stanford Medicine Palo Alto hospital campus and the Stanford University campus.
