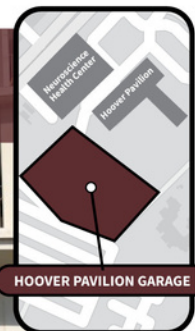

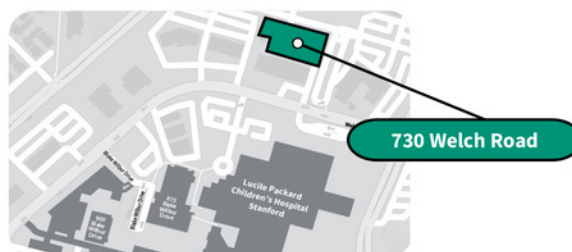
Enter the Hoover Garage by scanning your badge between 4PM - 4AM, and park LL2 or LL3.

How to park in

730 WELCH LOT



Parking is allowed from 6PM - 8AM when clinic is closed but vehicles **must** exit the lot before 8AM



730 Welch Road

NO NIGHT SHIFT PARKING IS ALLOWED IN ANY OF THE FOLLOWING WELCH ROAD PROPERTIES: 700, 750, 770, 777
A valid Welch Road parking permit is required at all times in those lots.

Please note that Stanford University permit parking, including A/C permits, are enforced 6 AM - 4 PM weekday, only unless otherwise posted. Parking restrictions in special zones, such as disabled parking, red zones, fire lanes, D spaces, and special permit - only spaces are enforced 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

You must NOT park in any space that is marked as "Reserved Parking for Patients & Visitors Only". Parking in a reserved space will result in a \$46.00 parking invoice.

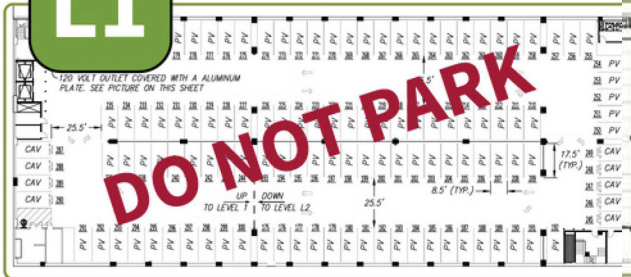


Transportation Services will record your license plate and reserves the right to issue citations if the above requirements are not met.
