


PARKING FOR EMERGENT ON-CALL STAFF WITH A RESPONSE TIME OF 30 MINUTES OR LESS



Emergency On-call staff with a response time of 30 minutes or less may park in the reserved Emergent On-Call Staff parking spaces in the 500P - Pasteur Staff Garage or the 300 Pasteur ED Surface Lot.



How to park for emergency on-call response:

1. Apply for a complimentary permit. Be sure to add your vehicle's license plate information and badge number. Apply online here: http://stanfordmedicinetransportation.org/On-Call-Permit-Form



- 2. Once your application has been reviewed and approved, the Hospital Transportation Operations Center will reach out via email to provide instructions on how to get your permit and badge access for the 500P -Pasteur Staff Garage
- 3. When arriving for emergency on-call response, park in the designated spaces with a blue "Emergent On-Call Staff" sign. You must have badge access to enter the 500P -Pasteur Staff Garage
- 4. Permit must be visible on vehicle dashboard at all times while parked in "Emergent On-Call Staff" spaces
- 5. Ensure that the Hospital Transportation Services Department has a record of your vehicle license plate.


Abuse of parking privileges will be reported to your department leader.



PARKING FOR GENT ON-CALL STAFF **RESPONSE TIME OF 30 MINUTES OR LESS**


ADULT AND TRAUMA EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT AT 500 PASTEUR DRIVE
