

Staff Electric Vehicle (EV) charging stations can be found in university parking lots and garages on the main Stanford Campus. A ChargePoint account is required to pay for parking and charging in these spaces.

These charging spaces are available to the public, no A or C parking permit necessary. However, your electric vehicle must be plugged in to utilize these spaces. Vehicles that are not plugged in and paying will be subject to citation.
