Stanford Health Care Employees can take advantage of a wide range of alternative commuter options

Santa Clara Park and Ride



Park in the Santa Clara Park and Ride lot and ride the shuttle to the Palo Alto campus



Free Transit Passes

Ride Caltrain, VTA, and AC Transit buses and trains for free.

Pre-tax Commuter Benefits



Use pre-tax dollars to pay for BART tickets, parking, and other commuting costs.



East Bay Commuter Buses

Park in the East Bay for free and avoid paying the Dumbarton bridge tolls.

Lyft for Business



Use Lyft for all business meeting travel and expense your department's account.



Zipcar

Join Zipcar with discounted rates and membership fees.

Bicycle



Enjoy plenty of bike amenities when you bike to work.

Live in the East Bay? Skip the toll by using one of our East Bay Park & Ride locations.

On-Site Parking



Scarce, hard to find, and not a preferred option

Staff may park in S-9 Hoover Pavilion Garage, S-5 Stock Farm Garage, or S-3 Pasteur Staff Garage, with a valid permit. Free park & ride lots are available to staff in Newark and Menlo Park


