### Updated Parking Pricing for Stanford Medicine Employees

Starting on Friday, September 1, 2023, staff parking prices will increase for Stanford University 'A', 'C', and 'Z' permits, the 500 Pasteur - Pasteur Staff Garage, and the hospital Welch Road Properties.



One of the parking pricing updates is for the Pasteur Staff Garage, which will increase the daily parking permit to \$12 for all Stanford Health Care (SHC) employees

**Effective on Friday, September 1, 2023,** staff parking prices at the Stanford Medicine Palo Alto Campus will increase. Changes will be made to Stanford University permits, Pasteur Staff Garage daily permits, and Welch Road permits.

### **NEW Parking Permit Eligibility for 'A' Parking Permits:**

All Stanford Health Care (SHC) and Lucile Packard Children's Hospital (LPCH) employees will now be eligible to buy an 'A' parking permit regardless of hire date!

### **Pricing Updates**

Permit pricing will update as follows:

### <u>'C' Parking Permit</u>

- Monthly parking permit rate: \$40
- Daily parking permit rate: \$6.50
- Stanford Health Care (SHC) & Lucile Packard Children's Hospital (LPCH) employees hired before January 1, 2019
- All residents/fellows are excluded from the January 1, 2019 hire date restriction because they are part of educational program rotation. This means all residents/fellows are eligible to purchase a 'C' parking permit

### <u>'Z' Parking Permit</u>

- Monthly parking permit rate: \$40
- Daily parking permit rate: \$6.50
- Stanford Health Care (SHC) & Lucile Packard Children's Hospital (LPCH) employees hired after January 1, 2019

### • NEW Eligibility - <u>'A' Parking Permit</u>

- Monthly parking permit rate: \$133
- Daily parking permit rate: \$19
- Available for all Stanford Health Care (SHC) employees, Lucile Packard Children's Hospital (LPCH) employees, and hospital residents/fellows at Stanford Medicine regardless of hire date
- 'MC' Motorcycle Permit
  - Monthly parking permit rate: \$14.75
  - Daily parking permit rate: \$3
  - Available for all hospital employees
- 500 Pasteur Pasteur Staff Garage Parking Permit
  - Daily parking permit rate: \$12
  - Available for all SHC employees
- Welch Road Hospital Administrative Buildings (700, 730, 732, 750, 770, 777, 900, 1000, and 1190 Welch)
  - Monthly parking permit rate: \$133
  - Daily parking permit rate: \$12
  - To park, you must be an employee assigned to one of the listed buildings AND be approved by your department leader for on-site parking
    - Please reach out to your department leader for any questions about parking eligibility at these locations

### Why Are These Changes Happening?

The pricing changes are occurring to help manage parking demand. Even with the increased prices, Stanford Medicine parking pricing is still lower than many other California Academic medical centers.

### How Can I Save Money?

Transportation Services provides several free commuting options including Park & Ride shuttles, vanpool, bike to work, and reimbursed public transportation.

In addition, a new carpool program will be available on September 1, 2023, for the Pasteur Staff Garage, to provide free or discounted parking to participating employees!

## Staff Parking Updates for 'A' and 'C' Permit Parking

Parking stalls by permit type have been adjusted to level out demand. These changes are for the Hoover Pavilion Garage, the Center for Academic Medicine (CAM) Garage, and the Hoover Pavilion South Lot (Lot 1).



The updated parking map above shows parking availability for 'A', 'C', and 'Z' permits near the CAM garage

Parking capacity in the Center for Academic Medicine (CAM) Garage has been limited over the recent months.

To manage demand, updates have been made to the parking permit locations in the CAM Garage, the Hoover Pavilion South Lot (Lot 1), and the Hoover Pavilion Garage (HPG).

### Timeline of Parking Changes (Organized by Effective Date)

### Monday, August 7, 2023

- Hoover Pavilion South Lot (Lot 1)
  - All 'A' permit spaces have been converted to 'C' permit stalls
    - This adds more parking options for 'C' permit holders
    - The 'A' parking permit spaces in this lot are under-used
    - This lot was previously all 'C' permit parking. 'A' permit parking was added during construction of the Center for Academic Medicine, which is now open

### Monday, August 14, 2023

- Center for Academic Medicine (CAM) Garage
  - Some 'C' parking permit stalls on level 2 were converted to 'A' parking permit stalls
    - This garage is in high demand and fills up daily
    - The conversion of some 'C' parking permit spaces to 'A' parking permit spaces will help adjust to the high demand in the area
    - Stanford University will continue to monitor the utilization of this garage in the coming months and will make additional adjustments in batches to meet demand
- Hoover Pavilion Garage
  - All staff parking levels (levels 1-6) have been converted to 'Z' parking permit only. No 'C' parking permits are allowed in this garage
    - 'Z' parking permit holders are limited to only be able to park in the Hoover Pavilion Garage and the rooftop of the Stock Farm Garage
    - This conversion helps ensure that new employees are able to find a 'Z' parking permit space

### Monday, August 28, 2023

- Center for Academic Medicine (CAM) Garage
  - The CAM garage will be gated for employee access only between 8:00 PM - 5:00 AM daily
    - Access to the garage will be restricted to employees only after hours
    - All employees will have badge access to the garage

*If you would like to continue parking in the CAM garage, it is strongly recommended that you purchase an 'A' permit, which is now available for all* 

#### employees regardless of hire date.

### You can purchase an 'A' permit through Stanford Transportation's online portal.

If you wish to change to an 'A' parking permit, it is highly recommended that you make this change during the transition between months, such as on August 31 or September 1. This will ensure you will not have to pay twice for the same month.

If you do not wish to purchase an 'A' permit, there is limited 'C' parking available on level 2 and 3 of CAM garage, and 'C' parking stalls available in the Hoover Pavilion Lot South Lot (Lot 1).

As part of the transition, signs have been deployed to inform permit holders when 'C' parking is full at the CAM garage, and parking attendants are stationed to inform you of alternative parking options.

If you choose to park in Lot 1, there is a free shuttle that runs between the Hoover shuttle stop at Quarry Road and Sweet Olive Way, Lucile Packard Children's Hospital, and 500 Pasteur. For details about staff shuttles serving this area, including route maps and schedules, see below.
