Looking to save money, exercise more, or reduce your carbon footprint this year? Start with your daily commute!

The Stanford Medicine FREE alternative commuting options and benefits can help you achieve sustainability or savings goals for the new year!

#### **Commuter Buses**

Instead of stressing about driving, enjoy a free bus ride from <u>Campbell, Santa Clara</u>, or the East Bay (on the <u>AE-F</u>, <u>EB</u>, or <u>Dumbarton Express</u>) to the Stanford Medicine Palo Alto campus.

#### NEW PARK & RIDE COMING SOON - Dec. 23, 2024:

The <u>Pleasanton Park & Ride Lot &</u> <u>Shuttle Program</u> will offer FREE parking and a direct shuttle ride from the Tri-Valley area to the Stanford Medicine Palo Alto campus, with stops at Stanford Health Care (SHC) and Lucile Packard Children's Hospital (LPCH).

### COMING SOON - Jan. 1, 2025:

Eligible SHC and LPCH employees who work on-site at one of the following Welch addresses can receive \$25 per month. (700, 750, 770, 777, 801, 900, 1000, 1100 Welch)

### <u>Vanpool</u>

Vanpools with five or more Stanford colleagues can lease a commute vanpool for FREE (eligibility requirements apply).

**COMING SOON - Swing & Night** 

fare-free rides on Caltrain with no restrictions.

### Pasteur Staff Garage Carpool Program

Get FREE or discounted parking at PSG! Two-person carpools receive 50% off (cost is \$6). Carpools with three or more and park for FREE.

#### **Shift Vanpool Eligibility**

Starting January 2024, Stanford Medicine Swing and Night Shift employees will be able to use the vanpool program during off-peak commuting hours.

#### **Pre-Tax Benefits**

Use pre-tax commuter benefits to pay for qualified commutes and parking expenses.

#### **COMING SOON**

The maximum transit and parking benefit will increase from \$315 to \$325 per month in 2025!

# Updated Stanford University Parking Permit Pricing

Starting Wednesday, January 1, 2025, pricing for staff parking permits at Stanford University parking garages/lots will increase.



Effective Jan. 1, 2025, pricing for staff parking permits at Stanford University parking garages/lots will increase to help manage parking demand. Stanford remains committed to offering fair pricing and the adjusted costs are lower than many other California Academic medical centers.

**NOTE:** There is no change to hospital-managed parking permit pricing at Pasteur Staff Garage or Welch Road Properties at this time.

The purchase process for permits will remain the same.
