## Clean Air Cash: Earn \$25/Month for Not Buying a Parking Permit

Eligible Stanford Health Care & Lucile Packard Children's Hospital employees who choose a sustainable commuting option can receive \$25/month as part of the Clean Air Cash trial.



### Go green and get rewarded with Clean Air Cash

Are you a full-time benefits-eligible Stanford Health Care & Lucile Packard Children's Hospital employee who works day shift onsite at the Stanford Medicine Palo Alto campus?

If you did not purchase a parking permit on this campus and you meet the requirements below, you can participate in the Clean Air Cash trial and receive \$25/month!

#### **Eligibility Requirements:**

- Must be a full-time, benefits-eligible employee of Stanford Health Care or Lucile Packard Children's Hospital.
- Must be a day shift employee working 100% on-site at the Stanford Medicine Palo Alto campus for 36 hours or more per week.
  - For the purposes of Clean Air Cash program eligibility, the Stanford Medicine Palo Alto campus **does not** include the following locations, which have staff parking options outside of the paid parking permit program:
    - Welch Road Properties (700, 750, 770, 777, 801, 900, 1000, 1100, or 1190 Welch Road)
    - Stanford Shopping Center
- To qualify for the payout, you cannot have a parking permit (daily or monthly) on file for more than 4 business days per month.

At this time, Stanford University employees, hybrid workers, remote workers, offsite staff, swing/evening/night shift, and rotational staff are not eligible for the trial program.

## Use Lyft for Business Related Trips and Ride for FREE

Eligible Stanford Health Care (SHC) & Lucile Packard Children's Hospital (LPCH) employees can use Lyft for business related trips at any time or place - no expense reports needed!



Get work done while on your Lyft ride to your business destination

The Lyft for Business program allows eligible Stanford Health Care (SHC) & Lucile Packard Children's Hospital (LPCH) employees to use Lyft for qualifying business trips for free. No need to worry about expense reports or parking fees. Once you are approved for the program, simply request a Lyft, hop in, and enjoy the ride!

By using the Lyft for Business program, you can enjoy these benefits:

- Door-to-door service: Go directly to your destination easily with Lyft for Business - no need to park at a lot or garage.

- More free time: Check your email, make phone calls, or just relax while your driver takes care of the driving.
- Save money and on the wear-and-tear of your personal vehicle. Use Lyft for business trips and reduce the need to bring your personal vehicle to work. When you use Lyft for business, you can carpool, vanpool, use transit, shuttle, or bicycle for your commute to work that day.
