The Santa Clara and Campbell Park & Ride lot and shuttle programs are convenient options for South Bay commuters heading to the Stanford Medicine Palo Alto hospital campus.

Commuting from the South Bay to the Stanford Medicine Palo Alto hospital campus?

Enjoy free parking and a comfortable ride to work with Stanford Medicine's Santa Clara and Campbell Park & Ride lot and shuttle programs. These Park & Ride lot and shuttle programs are available for Stanford Health Care and Lucile Packard Children's Hospital Staff.

With the Santa Clara and Campbell Park & Ride lot and shuttle programs, you can enjoy:

- Free parking
- Free wi-fi on the shuttle
- Convenient fuel delivery & earning a car wash with Yoshi!

[Santa Clara Park & Ride Lot and Shuttle Program](#)

The Santa Clara Park & Ride lot is located at 2945 Tasman Drive, Santa Clara, CA (near Levi's Stadium). The shuttle provides a direct connection from the lot to Lucile Packard Children's Hospital and 500 Pasteur.

The Santa Clara shuttle operates during peak morning and afternoon/evening commuting hours, with morning trips leaving Santa Clara between **4:20 AM - 8:20 AM**, and evening trips leaving the Palo Alto hospital campus between **2:30 PM - 8:25 PM**. The shuttle has a badge reader onboard. Staff boarding the shuttle will be asked to scan their staff ID badge upon entry.

A free parking hangtag is required to park in the Santa Clara Park & Ride lot. Apply for your free parking hangtag permit [here](#).

[Campbell Park & Ride Lot and Shuttle Program](#)

The Campbell Park & Ride lot is located at 600 E. Hamilton Ave, Campbell, CA - conveniently located off of Highway 17. The shuttle provides a direct connection from the lot to Lucile Packard Children's Hospital and 500 Pasteur.

The Campbell shuttle operates during peak morning and afternoon/evening commuting hours, with morning trips leaving Campbell between **5:10 AM - 8:20 AM**, and evening trips leaving the Palo Alto hospital campus between **2:30 PM - 7:30 PM**. The shuttle has a badge reader onboard. Staff boarding the shuttle will be asked to scan their staff ID badge upon entry.

A free parking hangtag is required to park in the Campbell Park & Ride lot. Apply for your free hangtag permit [here](#).

Earn a FREE detail car wash!

Staff who park at either Park & Ride lots at least 12 times in 1 month can earn a free car wash (\$89 value**).

**The value of the car wash will be taxable as imputed income. Claiming the free car wash is optional, and tax will not apply if the car wash is not accepted. Please reach out with any questions regarding the tax impact.

Commute to work this summer with Caltrain, biking, or both!

The summer season brings with it longer days and warmer weather. Take this opportunity to refresh your commute by boarding the Caltrain or biking to work!

Ditch the summer traffic and hop on the Caltrain

Traffic congestion is at its peak during the summer season. Why not make your commute stress-free by taking the Caltrain to work? Using this public transit option gives you the time to work, read, listen to music, or to watch your favorite television show!

As part of Stanford Medicine's Clipper card benefit, eligible Stanford Medicine employees can ride the Caltrain for free with the Caltrain Go Pass. This benefit is great for commuting to work, but you can also use it however you want like catching a weekend concert or attending a summer festival nearby!

Using the Caltrain Go Pass is easy! Simply scan your free Stanford Medicine Clipper card (pre-loaded with a Caltrain Go Pass) at a Caltrain station, then sit back and relax.

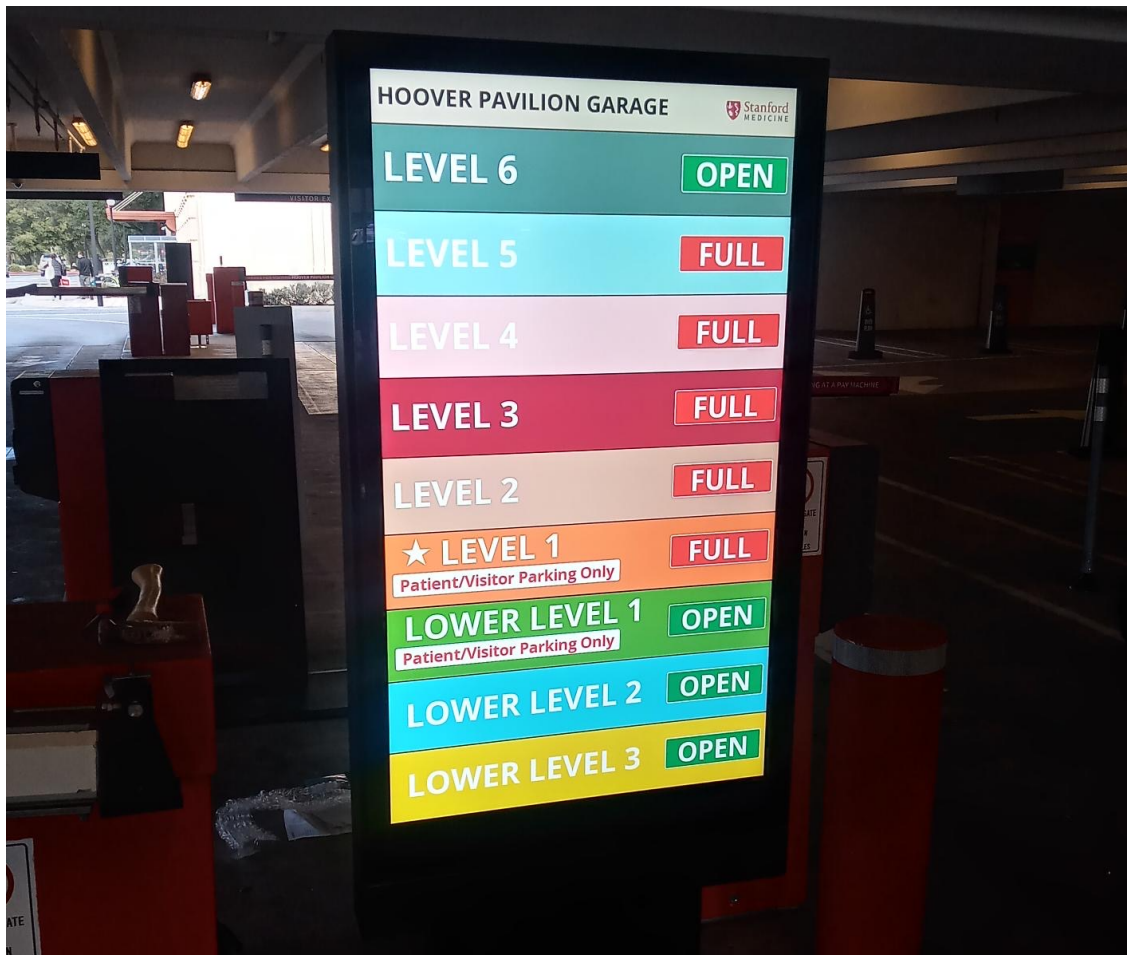
