Don't miss the chance to join the Electric Vehicle (EV) Expo and discover the benefits of going electric while enjoying some FREE ice cream!




Come engage with EV owners and enjoy FREE ice cream

In support of this goal, please keep in mind:


- Your fellow passengers are your colleagues. Treat all on board with respect and compassion in accordance with Stanford Health Care C-I-CARE and Stanford Medicine Children's Health PCARES
- 2. To ensure adequate seating for all passengers, use only one seat per person, and place personal items on the floor, in your lap, or in a storage area, if available
- 3. To keep buses clean and comfortable, do not put your feet up on the seats
- 4. If there is a large group when preparing to board the bus, form a line to enter the vehicle

- 5. For efficient deboarding at your destination, allow anyone sitting in front of you off of the bus first
- 6. Help your fellow passengers enjoy a peaceful ride by using headphones for any audio
- 7. When speaking on the phone, keep voice to a reasonable speaking level

Details:

- The proposed project aims to construct a roadway for transit vehicles, providing a connection from the Palo Alto Transit Center to the intersection of Quarry Road and El Camino Real.
- The project is designed to significantly reduce bus transit times by an estimated 5-8 minutes per trip.
- Additionally, the project will improve pedestrian and bicycle paths in El Camino Park and at Quarry Road and El Camino Real. These enhancements are designed to improve safety, accessibility, and connectivity to the city's pedestrian and bicycle network.

The Santa Clara Park & Ride lot (near Levi Stadium) and the Campbell Park & Ride lot (formerly the old Fry's Electronics lot) provide free parking and transportation for staff at the Stanford Medicine Palo Alto hospital campus. Enjoy easy, free parking and a direct shuttle ride that connects directly to Lucile Packard Children's Hospital and 500 Pasteur!

Commuting from the East Bay?

East Bay staff can park for free at the Ardenwood Park & Ride lot (Ardenwood Blvd. & Hwy. 84), which is located in Fremont. This lot connects with transbay commuter busses to the Stanford Medicine Palo Alto hospital campus and the Stanford University campus.
