## Clean Air Cash: Ditch the Parking Permit and Earn \$25/Month

Eligible Stanford Health Care & Lucile Packard Children's Hospital employees who choose a sustainable commuting option may be eligible for the Clean Air Cash trial.



## Go green and get rewarded with Clean Air Cash

Are you a full-time benefits-eligible Stanford Health Care & Lucile Packard Children's Hospital employee who works day shift onsite at the Stanford Medicine Palo Alto campus?

If you didn't purchase a parking permit on this campus and you meet the requirements below, you can participate in the Clean Air Cash trial and receive \$25/month!

### **Eligibility Requirements:**

- Must be a full-time, benefits-eligible employee of Stanford Health Care or Lucile Packard Children's Hospital
- Must be a day shift employee working 100% on-site at the Stanford Medicine Palo Alto campus for 36 hours or more per week
- To qualify for the payout, you cannot have a parking permit (daily or monthly) on file for more than 4 business days per month

*At this time, Stanford University employees, hybrid workers, remote workers, offsite staff, swing/evening/night shift, and rotational staff are not eligible for the trial program.*

## Patient Golf Cart Service Expands to Weekend Operations

The patient golf cart service is now available on weekends for patients & visitors at the Stanford Medicine Palo Alto campus.



Patients & visitors can take advantage of the convenient golf cart service to get around the Stanford Medicine Palo Alto campus

Stanford Medicine Transportation Services has recently expanded their complimentary patient golf cart service to operate seven days a week!

The golf cart service provides transportation to patients and visitors between the Pasteur Visitor Garage (PVG), 500 Pasteur, 300 Pasteur, and 875/900 Blake Wilbur Clinics.

The service now operates from Monday to Sunday between 6:00 AM – 9:00 PM, providing a frequency of 3-5 minutes at each of the stops.

At each stop, there's a golf cart request call box, which allows a patient or visitor to request a ride on demand.



Upon pushing the "push to call" button, the call box will immediately radio the transportation operations team and a driver will be dispatched to the requestor's location. If needed, the requestor can also use the call box to communicate with the driver to ask questions or provide more information.
