promoting sustainable commuting with Stanford Medicine Transportation Services contact information.

Inside, you can discover various sustainable transportation programs available to you as a Stanford Medicine staff member such as <u>Clean Air Cash</u>, <u>Pasteur Staff Garage Carpool Program</u>, and the <u>Santa Clara</u> and <u>Campbell</u> Park & Ride programs. There are even tablets available for easy sign-up!



Eligible employees can also come to the Transportation Pop-Up to get a <u>Clipper Card</u> pre-loaded with Caltrain Go Pass, Valley Transportation Authority (VTA) SmartPass, and Alameda-Contra-Costa (AC) Transit EasyPass! These passes are good for unlimited travel anytime on Caltrain, VTA, and AC Transit!


