New Pre-Tax Commuter Benefits Provider

Stanford Health Care is transitioning from Edenred to HealthEquity for Pre-Tax Commuter Benefits



Stanford Health Care has begun transitioning from the current Edenred Commuter Benefits platform to a new commuter benefits platform on [HealthEquity](#). The HealthEquity platform will have the same program eligibility and similar benefits as the Edenred platform.

If you do not currently participate in the Edenred commuter benefits program, you might want to think about participating in HealthEquity to save money on transit and parking expenses.

Why choose Pre-Tax Parking & Transit Benefits?

- **Unlock Savings:** Optimize your commuting budget by utilizing pre-tax dollars for parking expenses!

The first benefit month on the HealthEquity platform will be January 2024.

The window to place an order in HealthEquity for the January 2024 benefits month is now open, and runs through December 10. Effective immediately, no new orders can be placed in Edenred. The deadline to place future orders in HealthEquity will continue to be the 10th of the month prior to the benefits month.

Lucile Packard Children's Hospital will also transition pre-tax commuter benefits to HealthEquity 1 month later than Stanford Health Care, with a first benefits month of February 2024. More information will be available for Lucile Packard Children's Hospital Employees in early December

More American with Disabilities Act (ADA) Stalls Added at the Blake Wilbur Surface Lot

Stanford Medicine Transportation Services recently added 14 ADA stalls for patients and visitors looking to park at the Blake Wilbur Surface Lot.



Another project completed!

Stanford Medicine Transportation Services recently completed the addition of 14 American with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant parking spaces at the Blake Wilbur Surface Lot, in accordance with City of Palo Alto code requirements.

With this addition, the Blake Wilbur Surface Lot now offers 16 ADA parking spaces, a significant increase from the original 2, for the convenience of patients and visitors.

The Santa Clara Park & Ride lot (near Levi Stadium) and the Campbell Park & Ride lot (formerly the old Fry's Electronics lot) provide free parking and transportation for staff at the Stanford Medicine Palo Alto hospital campus. Enjoy easy, free parking and a direct shuttle ride that connects directly to Lucile Packard Children's Hospital and 500 Pasteur!
