Commute with Clipper Card

Stanford Medicine provides eligible employees with a Clipper card pre-loaded with a Caltrain Go Pass, a Valley Transit Authority (VTA) SmartPass, and an Alameda-Contra Costa (AC) Transit EasyPass, allowing for unlimited travel.



Whether you're commuting to work or running essential errands,
Clipper card makes traveling easy!

Did you know, eligible employees can receive a FREE Clipper card, pre-loaded with an unlimited pass for Caltrain, VTA, and AC Transit (for East Bay residents)?



Eligible employees can also use pre-tax dollars to load transit passes from other Bay Area agencies onto their Clipper card, as well as add funds for transit parking, bike parking, and bike share.

 - For Caltrain and Stanford Medicine Park & Ride programs, make sure to scan your Clipper card or Stanford Medicine identification badge when boarding.
2. After taking one of the commute modes above at least 10 times in November, visit the Transportation Pop-Up (on North Pasteur Drive) to verify your trips and receive your prize.

Prize

Staff who meet the requirements above will receive a \$15 meal voucher.

Meal vouchers will have no expiration date and can be used at the 500 Pasteur Cafeteria or The Perk Coffee shop and Locally Crafted in 300 Pasteur.
