Please see the schedules below:



The new electric service will include shortened travel times and increased service during peak and off-peak times.

Limited Spots Still Available for FREE Caltrain Parking Permits

Exchange your monthly campus parking permit and park at any Caltrain station for FREE with the Caltrain Parking pilot program.



The Caltrain Parking pilot program is available on a first come, first served basis.

Limited spots are still available!

Are you a full-time benefits-eligible Stanford Health Care & Lucile Packard Children's Hospital employee who works day shift onsite at the Stanford Medicine Palo Alto campus?

If so, you have the opportunity to participate in the Caltrain Parking pilot program where the first 200 employees who sign up and are approved for the

program will receive a FREE Caltrain monthly parking permit (valued at \$82.50) provided by Stanford Medicine Transportation Services.

Details for eligibility and how to apply are included below.

NOTE: The Caltrain Parking pilot program is intended for new staff or existing staff who are currently purchasing parking at the Stanford Medicine Palo Alto campus.

The Caltrain Parking pilot program is still accepting a limited number of employees. The window to apply to this program will only be open for a couple of months. If you meet the requirements and would like to apply, please do so as soon as possible!

Eligibility Requirements

New employees

- 1. Must be a full time (25+ hours/week) and benefited Stanford Health Care or Lucile Packard Children's Hospital employee
- 2. Apply for the program within the first 30 days of employment 30 days starting from New Employee Orientation for Stanford Health Care and Team Members On-boarding for Stanford Medicine Children's Health
- 3. Must work on campus & live in the Bay Area
- 4. You are encouraged to enroll in the <u>Clean Air Cash (CAC) pilot program</u>

Existing Employees

- 1. Must be a full time (25+ hours/week) and benefited Stanford Health Care or Lucile Packard Children's Hospital employee
- 2. Have held an active monthly Stanford University parking permit (or purchased a Pasteur Staff Garage daily permit more than 5 times a month) for the past 3 months (you must discontinue use of parking

permits at the Stanford Medicine Palo Alto campus to qualify)

- 3. Must work on campus & live in the Bay Area
- 4. You are encouraged to enroll in the <u>Clean Air Cash (CAC) pilot program</u>

How It Works:

- 1. Apply to the program via the Smartsheet Form here
- 2. Stanford Medicine Transportation Services will review applications for approval
 - Applications will be reviewed in the order in which they are received
 - The first 200 qualified applicants will be selected for the program
- 3. If you are selected for the program, you will be notified via email
 - If you applied prior to the 15th of the month, you will receive parking for the next month (e.g., apply by July 15th to receive parking for August)
 - If you applied after the 15th of the month, you will receive parking for the month after next (e.g., apply July 16th through August 15th to receive parking for September)
- 4. Receive your permit at the Transportation Pop-Up (located near the 500 Pasteur shuttle stop) and start parking at any Caltrain station for FREE

Promotion

How it Works

- 1. Carpool to PSG using the PSG carpool program
- 2. After taking carpooling at least 12 times in September, visit the Transportation Pop-Up (on North Pasteur Drive) on or after Wednesday, September 18, 2024, to verify your trips and receive your prize

Prize

Staff can select from a range of prizes, such as lunch boxes, backpacks, hats, water bottles, tumblers, power banks, and Apple AirTags.

Get FREE & Discounted Parking with the PSG Carpool Program

The Pasteur Staff Garage (PSG) carpool program is available for all Stanford Health Care staff and will allow you to get free or discounted parking at PSG.

How to enroll in the program:

- 1. Fill out the carpool program sign-up form to get matched with a group!
 - a. In the form, you will have the option to identify if you have a preselected group
- 2. Once matched with a group, use the Stanford Medicine Parking App to book a discounted PSG parking permit
- 3. Discounts are based on vehicle occupancy:
 - a. Single Occupancy: 0% discount (\$12)
 - b. Two-Person Occupancy: 50% discount (\$6)
 - c. Three or More Occupancy: 100% discount (\$0)

The Santa Clara Park & Ride lot (near Levi Stadium) and the Campbell Park & Ride lot (formerly the old Fry's Electronics lot) provide free parking and transportation for staff at the Stanford Medicine Palo Alto campus. Enjoy easy, free parking and a direct shuttle ride that connects directly to Lucile Packard Children's Hospital and 500 Pasteur!
