Monthly Parking Permits

Save money on parking with a long-term (monthly) parking permit



Purchasing a monthly parking permit can help you save on parking expenses.

Stanford Health Care staff hired **before** May 2013 & Lucile Packard Children's Hospital staff hired **before** August 2010 are eligible to purchase an 'A' or 'C' permit

- 'A' Parking Permits provide many premium convenient parking options close to the hospitals such as Roth Way Garage
 - Monthly Cost: \$116Daily Cost: \$16.25
- 'C' Parking Permits provide many convenient parking options such as Stock Farm Garage and Hoover Pavilion Garage
 - Monthly Cost: \$35Daily Cost: \$5.45

Staff hired after those dates are eligible to purchase a 'Z' permit

 'Z' Parking Permits provide parking at Hoover Pavilion Garage and Searsville Lot Monthly Cost: \$35Daily Cost: \$5.45


Independent Contractors who are onboarded into MyWorkday (SHC) or PeopleSoft (LPCH) may request sponsorship to purchase a 'Z' permit.
