

Holiday Transportation Reminders Shuttle schedules and parking enforcement around the holidays



The winter holidays are coming up!

Due to decreased demand over the holidays, many shuttles will be running reduced or no service on Friday, December 25th and Friday, January 1st.

Parking will continue to be enforced 24/7 **except** on:

- Friday, December 25th, 2020
- Friday, January 1st, 2021

Transit Passes Extended
Caltrain Go Pass, VTA SmartPass, and AC Transit EasyPass extended into 2021



As compensation for service reductions and loss of use due to COVID-19 shelterin-place orders, Caltrain Go Pass, VTA SmartPass, and AC Transit EasyPass have all been extended into 2021.

- 2020 Stanford Caltrain Go Passes are now valid through March 31, 2021
- 2020 Stanford VTA SmartPasses are now valid through April 30, 2021
- 2020 Stanford AC Transit EasyPasses are extended through the end of 2021

No action is required on the part of current pass holders.
