COMING SOON: Campbell Park & Ride Lot and Shuttle

Residents of Campbell, Willow Glen, and surrounding areas will soon have access to a new, FREE Park & Ride Lot and Shuttle with a direct connection to the main hospital campus.



The new Campbell shuttle will provide a convenient and comfortable ride directly to Lucile Packard Children's Hospital and 500 Pasteur

A new FREE Campbell Park & Ride Lot and Shuttle pilot program is coming soon for Stanford Health Care and Lucile Packard Children's Hospital staff - opening on **Monday, February 20, 2023.**

This new park and ride lot will be located at **600 E Hamilton Ave, Campbell, CA** - conveniently located off of Highway 17. The shuttle will provide a direct connection from the lot to Lucile Packard Children's Hospital and 500 Pasteur.

With the Campbell Park & Ride Lot and Shuttle, you can enjoy:

- Free parking
- Free Wi-Fi while traveling on the shuttle
- Convenient fuel delivery & earned car washes with Yoshi!

A free parking hangtag will be required to park in the Campbell Park & Ride Lot. Apply for your free hangtag permit [here](#).

Campbell Shuttle:

The new shuttle will operate during peak morning and afternoon/evening commuting hours, with morning trips leaving Campbell between 6:00am - 9:00am, and evening trips leaving the main hospital campus between 3:00pm - 7:15pm. A detailed schedule will be available in the coming weeks.

The shuttle will have a badge reader onboard. Staff boarding the shuttle will be asked to scan their staff ID badge upon entry.

Fuel & Wash at the Park & Ride!

Staff who have a valid (free) Campbell Park & Ride hangtag permit are eligible to sign up for Yoshi fuel delivery service at no additional cost. If you use the app to buy gas, a delivery truck will come and fill up your tank while you're at work!

- Fuel will be comparably priced with local gas stations
- No delivery fee*
- Just schedule, leave your fuel hatch open, and come back to a full tank!

**Up to 6 deliveries per month. A delivery fee will apply to the 7th, 8th, etc delivery within 1 month.*

Earn a FREE detail car wash!

Staff who park at the Campbell Park & Ride lot at least 12 times in 1 month can earn a free car wash (\$89 value!**).

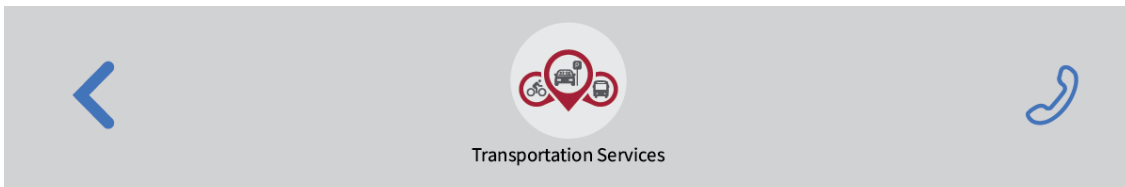
***the value of the car wash will be taxable as imputed income. Claiming the free car wash is optional, and tax will not apply if the car wash is not accepted. Please reach out with any questions regarding the tax impact.*
