Increased Capacity in the Redwood City Outpatient Center Bike Room

Additional bike parking for Stanford Medicine Outpatient Center staff



The bike room at the Stanford Medicine Outpatient Center in Redwood City has been upgraded.

Thanks to the the new bike racks installed, the bike room now has capacity for up to 30 bicycles at a time, compared to the previous capacity of 24.

With this upgrade, a bike pump has also been installed outside of the bike room, for convenient maintenance.
