The Campbell Park & Ride Lot and Shuttle is Now Available!

Residents of Campbell, Willow Glen, and surrounding areas can now use the Campbell Park & Ride Lot and Shuttle to go to Lucile Packard Children's Hospital and 500 Pasteur.

Stanford Medicine's Campbell Park & Ride Lot and Shuttle pilot program is now available for Stanford Health Care and Lucile Packard Children's Hospital staff.

This new park and ride lot is located at **600 E Hamilton Ave, Campbell, CA** - conveniently located off of Highway 17. The shuttle provides a direct connection from the lot to Lucile Packard Children's Hospital and 500 Pasteur.

With the Campbell Park & Ride Lot and Shuttle, you can enjoy:

- Free parking
- Free Wi-Fi while traveling on the shuttle
- Convenient fuel delivery & earned car washes with Yoshi!

A free parking hangtag is required to park in the Campbell Park & Ride Lot. Apply for your free hangtag permit <u>here</u>.

Campbell Shuttle:

The shuttle operates during peak morning and afternoon/evening commuting hours, with morning trips leaving Campbell between 6:00am - 9:00am, and evening trips leaving the main hospital campus between 3:00pm - 7:15pm.

The shuttle has a badge reader onboard. Staff boarding the shuttle will be asked to scan their staff ID badge upon entry.

Fuel & Wash at the Park & Ride!

Staff members who have a valid (free) Campbell Park & Ride hangtag permit are eligible to sign up for Yoshi fuel delivery service at no additional cost. If you use

the app to buy gas, a delivery truck will come and fill up your tank while you're at work!

- Fuel will be comparably priced with local gas stations
- No delivery fees*
- Just schedule the fueling, leave your fuel hatch open, and come back to a full tank!

*Up to 6 deliveries per month. A delivery fee will apply to the 7th, 8th, etc. delivery within 1 month.

Earn a FREE detail car wash!

Staff who park at the Campbell Park & Ride lot at least 12 times in 1 month can earn a free car wash (\$89 value**).

**the value of the car wash will be taxable as imputed income. Claiming the free car wash is optional, and tax will not apply if the car wash is not accepted. Please reach out with any questions regarding the tax impact.

The Hoover Pavilion Garage Adds New Electric Vehicle (EV) Chargers

Staff and patients can now enjoy convenient EV Charging at the Hoover Pavilion Garage.

EV charging stations were recently installed at the Hoover Pavilion Garage (217 Quarry Road, Palo Alto) to accommodate both staff and patients, and a ribboncutting ceremony was held on February 9th to celebrate the installation. The Hoover Pavilion Garage EV charging stations is Stanford Medicine's latest milestone toward sustainable transportation.

The EV charging stations can be found on the street level of the Hoover Pavilion Garage. The same rules for parking in the garage apply to the charging stations - a valid 'C' or 'Z' parking permit is required for staff parking and hourly payment for patient parking.

In accordance with the City of Palo Alto's guidelines, the new charging stations will charge in kWh (Kilowatt-Hour) increments rather than a flat hourly rate. Users will be billed based on the amount of electricity consumed rather than the length of time the vehicle was plugged in. The EV charging costs will be applied in addition to garage rates.

At Stanford Medicine, biking is not only encouraged, but it's also made easier with bicycle parking, showers, and repair stations available all around the main campus.

One of the latest additions to Stanford Medicine's biking facilities is the Hoover Bike Cage. The new bicycle parking facility provides parking for over 40 bicycles and is accessible using a Stanford Health Care or Lucile Packard Children's Hospital staff ID badge. The bike cage is conveniently located near the shower and locker room at Hoover Pavilion so you can freshen up after your ride.
