NEW PERK: New Yoshi Fuel Program at SRI Park & Ride Lot

Fuel & Wash at SRI Park & Ride!



The new Yoshi fuel delivery program makes the SRI Park & Ride even more convenient!

Stanford Medicine Transportation Services is partnering with Yoshi, a contactless gas and automotive service company, to make parking at the SRI Park & Ride Lot even more convenient.

Staff with a valid (free) SRI Park & Ride hangtag permit can sign up for Yoshi fuel delivery with no membership fee. Use the app to purchase fuel, and a delivery vehicle will fill up your tank while you're at work!

- Fuel will be comparably priced with local gas stations
- No delivery fee*
- Just schedule, leave your fuel hatch open, and come back to a full tank!

*Up to 6 deliveries per month. A delivery fee will apply to the 7th, 8th, etc delivery within 1 month.

Earn a FREE detail car wash!

Staff who park at the SRI Park & Ride lot at least 12 times in 1 month can earn a free car wash (\$89 value!**).

Badge readers will be available in the SRI shuttle to allow parkers to scan in. Parkers must scan their badge to work towards earning the car wash.

**the value of the car wash will be taxable as imputed income. Please reach out with any questions regarding the tax impact.
