SRI Park & Ride Lot and Shuttle

Free Parking with a Direct Shuttle Connection to 500 Pasteur and Lucile Packard Children's Hospital



The SRI Park & Ride Lot in Menlo Park provides free parking and shuttle service directly to 500 Pasteur and Lucile Packard Children's Hospital Main.

Use the free SRI Shuttle to get from the park & ride lot to Lucile Packard Children's Hospital or 500 Pasteur in **under 20 minutes**!

Parking Reminders for 500P and 300P Staff

Pasteur Staff Garage and Alternative Options for Hospital Staff



Driving to the main hospital campus for work? The 500P - Pasteur Staff Garage (PSG) is a convenient daily parking option.

The Pasteur Staff Garage:

- Provides <u>free motorcycle parking</u> for staff
- Is the closest staff parking option to 500P

A daily parking permit (\$8/day) is required to park at the Pasteur Staff Garage. Permits can be purchased via the Passport Parking App (Zone #1650)

Parking in the Pasteur Staff Garage is strictly enforced Monday - Friday, 6:00am - 4:00pm, and a parking attendant is stationed at the garage entrance starting at 4:00am. Stanford Medicine Transportation Services staff enforce inside the garage throughout the day.

Staff who park in the garage overnight must either exit the garage or purchase a new daily permit by 6:00am. Any unauthorized vehicle parked inside the garage without a permit during enforcement hours may be subject to fees and other repercussions.

staff on the main campus. Please keep in mind that staff must utilize designated staff parking locations.

Unless specifically authorized, staff may **not** park in:

- Patient and Visitor Parking Locations (including Pasteur Visitor Garage, Blake Wilbur Surface Lot, or Lucile Packard Children's Hospital Main and West Garages)
- Stanford Shopping Center (including Crate & Barrel, Container Store, and Nordstrom parking lots)
- Stanford West Apartments
- Welch Road properties without a Welch Road permit (700, 730, 732, 750, 770, 777, 900, 1000, 1100, and 1190 Welch Road)
