## Thanksgiving Holiday Staff Shuttle Schedule

Staff Shuttles for November 25th and 26th



Staff shuttles will run on limited schedules over the holiday

The Thanksgiving holiday is coming up!

With a decrease in riders over the holidays, many shuttles will be running reduced or no service on Thursday, November 25th and Friday, November 26th.

- [Hospital Direct \(HD\) Line](#): Limited service
  - Runs during peak hours only on Thursday, 11/25
    - 5:00am - 8:50am
    - 3:00pm - 5:50pm
  - Runs regular service on Friday, 11/26
- [Medical Center \(MC\) Line](#): Limited service
  - Runs during peak hours only on Thursday, 11/25 & Friday, 11/26
    - 5:06am - 8:16am
    - 2:52pm - 6:11pm
- [Evening Parking Shuttle \(EPS\)](#): Regular service

# REMINDER: More Hospital Staff Eligible for 'A' and 'C' Parking Permits

Effective December 2021: SHC and LPCH employees hired before January 1, 2018 will be eligible for an 'A' or 'C' permit, instead of a 'Z' permit



'A' and 'C' parking permits allow staff to park in many convenient parking locations close to the main hospitals

Effective Wednesday, December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021, Stanford Health Care and Lucile Packard Children's Hospital employees hired before January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018 will be eligible to purchase 'A' and 'C' parking permits from Stanford University's [online ordering portal](#).

Previously, 'A' and 'C' parking permits were only available to SHC employees hired before May 13<sup>th</sup>, 2013, and LPCH employees hired before August 9<sup>th</sup>, 2010. This exciting new eligibility expansion comes from a partnership between

hospital and university transportation teams.

## What does this mean for you?

If you were hired by SHC or LPCH **before** January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018:

- You will now be eligible to purchase an 'A' or 'C' parking permit instead of a 'Z' parking permit
- Starting November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2021, eligible staff will see the option to purchase an 'A' or 'C' permit with an effective date of 12/1/2021 or later in your virtual permit account in the [online ordering portal](#)
- If you currently have a 'Z' parking permit that renews monthly, it will expire on November 30<sup>th</sup>
- If you want to park beyond November 30<sup>th</sup>, please purchase an 'A' or 'C' permit

If you were hired **after** January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018:

- You are still eligible for a 'Z' permit, which allows you to park in Hoover Pavilion Garage or Stock Farm Garage
- 'Z' permit parking in Stock Farm Garage has been extended through August 31, 2022

Free after hours parking access is available

## Do you need to park in the 500P - Pasteur Staff Garage on evenings or weekends?

Parking badge access is available. Badge access will allow entry:

- 4pm-4am Monday - Friday
- Anytime on weekends

An exiting grace period has been added for overnight parkers. Overnight parkers **must** exit by 7am on weekdays or be subject to parking fees.
