New Stanford Medicine Parking App Launches November 15th

Parking in the 500P - Pasteur Staff Garage will require a daily permit (\$8) purchased from the new app



The new Stanford Medicine Parking app is available on app stores now, but accounts will not be active until Monday, November 15th

A new & improved parking experience is coming to the 500P - Pasteur Staff Garage.

Effective **November 15th, 2021***, The new parking app will be available for purchasing daily parking permits in the 500P - Pasteur Staff Garage (\$8)!

Passport Parking will no longer be used in the 500P - Pasteur Staff Garage as of November 15th, 2021.

With the new Stanford Medicine Parking app, users receive a QR code with their daily parking permit. Scan your unique QR code at the entry and exit machines of the garage



When you scan a valid QR code at the garage entry or exit, the gate will open and you can drive on through!

Exciting things are happening in parking as of December 1st to expand parking access for hospital staff!

Effective December 2021: SHC and LPCH employees hired before January 1, 2018 will be eligible for an 'A' or 'C' permit, instead of a 'Z' permit



'A' and 'C' parking permits allow staff to park in many convenient parking locations close to the main hospitals

CAM Garage will have 'C' permit parking

By December 1st, 2021, 'C' permit parking will be available on the lower 2 levels of the Center for Academic Medicine (CAM) Garage, located at 453 Quarry Road – near the intersection of Quarry & Welch.

The CAM Garage is conveniently located about a 2 minute (220 steps!) walk from Lucile Packard Children's Hospital, and about a 6 minute (660 steps!) walk from 300 Pasteur. This garage is a great new option for 'C' permit holders.

NEW! More Hospital Staff Eligible to Purchase 'A' and 'C' Parking Permits!

Effective Wednesday, December 1st, 2021, Stanford Health Care and Lucile Packard Children's Hospital employees hired before January 1st, 2018 will be eligible to purchase 'A' and 'C' parking permits from Stanford University's [online ordering portal](#).

Previously, 'A' and 'C' parking permits were only available to SHC employees hired before May 13th, 2013, and LPCH employees hired before August 9th, 2010. This exciting new eligibility expansion comes from a partnership between hospital and university transportation teams.

What does this mean for you?

If you were hired by SHC or LPCH **before** January 1st, 2018:

- You will now be eligible to purchase an 'A' or 'C' parking permit instead of

a 'Z' parking permit

- Starting November 3rd, 2021, eligible staff will see the option to purchase an 'A' or 'C' permit with an effective date of 12/1/2021 or later in your virtual permit account in the [online ordering portal](#)
- If you currently have a 'Z' parking permit that renews monthly, it will expire on November 30th
- If you want to park beyond November 30th, please purchase an 'A' or 'C' permit

If you were hired **after** January 1st, 2018:

- You are still eligible for a 'Z' permit, which allows you to park in Hoover Pavilion Garage or Stock Farm Garage
- 'Z' permit parking in Stock Farm Garage has been extended through August 31, 2022
