## **Commuting with Caltrain**

Caltrain can be a part of your commute, whether you are from San Francisco or Gilroy!





Check out the Caltrain service map to see which station is closest to you.

Commuting with Caltrain can be easy, free, and convenient!

Caltrain stations are conveniently located all the way from Gilroy to San Francisco! Simply hop on, scan your **free** Stanford Medicine Clipper card (preloaded with a Caltrain GoPass), then sit back and relax. Once you have arrived at the Palo Alto Caltrain Station, you can hop onto one of these three convenient staff shuttles to ride to the main hospital campus

• Line MC

- The Medical Center (MC) shuttle travels between the Palo Alto Transit Center, Stanford Health Care, and Lucile Packard Children's Hospital. Perfect for staff commuting to Lucile Packard Children's Hospital, Blake Wilbur Drive, Welch Road properties, and 500 Pasteur.
- Operating hours: 5:00 A.M. to 9:00 P.M.
- <u>Line X</u>
  - The Line X shuttle travels between the Palo Alto Transit Center and 300 Pasteur (via Quarry Road Extension). In the mornings, the X Express provides quick direct service to the 300 Pasteur Emergency Department!
  - Operating hours: 5:53 A.M. to 6:59 P.M.
- Line Y
  - The Line Y shuttle travels between 300 Pasteur (via Quarry Road Extension) and the Palo Alto Transit Center. In the afternoons, the Y Express provides quick direct service from the 300 Pasteur Emergency Department to Caltrain!
  - Operating hours: 6:39 A.M. to 6:59 P.M.

Stanford Medicine Clipper cards come pre-loaded with a free annual Caltrain Go Pass, VTA SmartPass, and staff can add funds <u>using pre-tax dollars</u> to use on all other major Bay Area transit systems such as BART, Muni, Golden Gate Transit, and more.

### **East Bay Commuter Buses**

Commuting from the East Bay doesn't have to be stressful



The AC Transit Line U is just one of the options for commuting from the East Bay to the Main Hospital Campus

Staff who live in the East Bay and travel to the Stanford Medicine Main Campus have a variety of **free** options to skip the toll and commute in style.

- AC Transit Line U & Marguerite Line AE-F
  - The Marguerite Line AE-F supplements the AC Transit Line U transbay service. Grab a ride from the Fremont BART station, Park & Ride at Wells Fargo, or Ardenwood Park & Ride, and enjoy a direct connection to the main Stanford Medicine campus, with drop offs on Quarry Road, Roth Way, and Palm Drive.
  - Line AE-F is free to all riders, and AC Transit Line U is free with your hospital ID.
- Marguerite Line EB
  - The East Bay Express (EB) travels from the Fremont & Union City BART Stations and Ardenwood Park & Ride directly to the Stanford Campus, with stops along Quarry Road.
  - Line EB is free to all riders.
- Line DB
  - The Dumbarton Express provides direct bus service from the East Bay to the peninsula. Stops at Ardenwood Park & Ride in the East Bay, and at Roth Way Garage on the Main Stanford Campus.
  - Eligible employees ride for free with a Stanford Medicine-provided <u>Clipper Card</u>

# **Evening Parking Shuttle (EPS)**

Need a ride late at night? The Evening Parking Shuttle is here to help!



The Evening Parking Shuttle is a convenient and free on-demand shuttle option for staff who leave work after 9:00 p.m.

The Evening Parking Shuttle (EPS) service is a free service designed to transport hospital staffs on demand from the **500 Pasteur Transportation Lounge**, **Lucile Packard Children's Hospital Main Lobby**, and **875 Blake Wilbur** to different parking locations around campus and the Palo Alto Transit Center between 9:00 p.m. – 4:00 a.m.

Hospital Transportation Services provides this service for Swing and Night shift hospital workers, whose shifts may end outside of regular shuttle service hours.

To request this on-demand service, call the **Facilities Services Response Center (FSRC)** at **650-498-4400**.
