Free staff shuttles are available between Hoover Pavilion parking, Stock Farm Garage & Lots, and the main hospital buildings

Dreading the walk from your car to the main hospital?

Try a free staff shuttle!

- Hospital Direct (HD)
 - Serves Hoover Pavilion, Stock Farm North Lot (Lot 18), 500 Pasteur, and Lucile Packard Children's Hospital!
- Medical Center (MC)
 - Serves Palo Alto Transit Center (Caltrain), Hoover Pavilion, 500 Pasteur, and Lucile Packard Children's Hospital!
- <u>SRI</u>
 - Serves SRI Park & Ride Lot, Hoover Pavilion, 500 Pasteur, and Lucile Packard Children's Hospital

Headed back to your car late at night? Try the Evening Parking Shuttle (EPS)!

• The Evening Parking Shuttle is an on-demand service that will pick you up at 500 Pasteur, 875 Blake Wilbur, or Lucile Packard Children's Hospital, and take you directly to your parking location on campus, or the Caltrain

station!

- The Evening Parking Shuttle runs from 9:00pm 4:00am on-demand every weekday
- Between 4:00am 5:00am, the Evening Parking Shuttle provides service from Hoover Pavilion to Lucile Packard Children's Hospital and 500 Pasteur

Be on Alert for Bicycle Theft and Vehicle Break-ins

Please be attentive to your surroundings when traveling around campus



The Department of Public Safety is seeking the community's assistance with preventing crime on campus

Stanford University recently sent out a notice regarding bicycle thefts and vehicle break ins on the University campus in September.

The Department of Public Safety is seeking the community's assistance with preventing crime on campus. The entire Stanford community benefits by your care & action.

- Please be attentive to your surroundings when traveling around campus, especially in parking lots and garages.
- When parking a bicycle, always lock your bike to a bike rack (wheels & frame) even when parking in a bike room or cage.
- A U-shaped lock is recommended for bikes, and a cable can be used in combination with the U-shaped lock for added security
- If you observe suspicious behavior or activity (see list below), please call **9-1-1** immediately.

Examples of suspicious behavior & activity include:

- An individual loitering around vehicles, looking underneath or into parked vehicles, or trying door handles of multiple vehicles.
- A vehicle stopped and still running behind another parked vehicle in a way that could conceal criminal activity.
- A person lying underneath a parked vehicle (as though working on the vehicle) in an area where it would be unusual for someone to be performing repairs which could be a theft of a catalytic converter.
- Activated car alarms
- A person scanning bikes in or around a bike rack
- A person using a tool to cut or disable a bike lock
