This new bicycle parking facility will provide parking for over 40 bicycles and will be accessible using a Stanford Health Care or Lucile Packard Children's Hospital staff ID badge. The bike cage is conveniently located near the shower & locker room at Hoover Pavilion so you can freshen after your ride. #### Did you know?

In the fiscal year 2022, Stanford Health Care Exterior Management shifted away from gasoline to electric-powered landscaping equipment. This gas to electric

conversion of landscaping equipment at Stanford Health Care has reduced greenhouse gas emissions by ~14 metric tons of carbon dioxide equivalent!

Benefits of conversion to electric-powered equipment include:

- Reduced reliance on fossil fuels
- Improvement in campus air quality & greenhouse gas emissions
- Contributing to culture of sustainability & electrification of operational equipment at Stanford Health Care
- Reduced noise pollution
