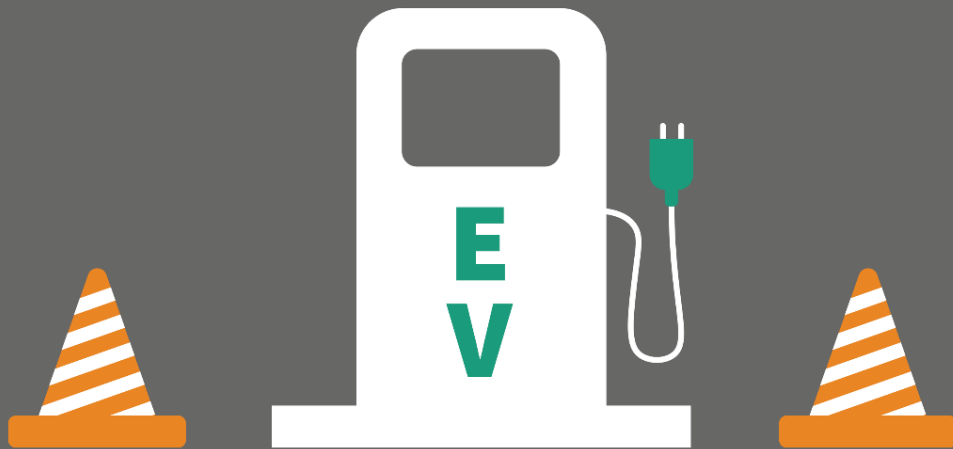
COMING SOON: Electric Vehicle

Transportation Services is excited to announce that construction to install new electric vehicle chargers at the [Hoover Pavilion Garage](#) (217 Quarry Road, Palo Alto) has started this week and is estimated to be completed by the end of this year. More details including usage guidelines and cost per charge will be announced when installation is closer to completion.

In the meantime, please be aware that there may be some noise and potential dust while navigating through the garage. Some spaces on street level and lower level 1 (Level L1) may be blocked off for installation.

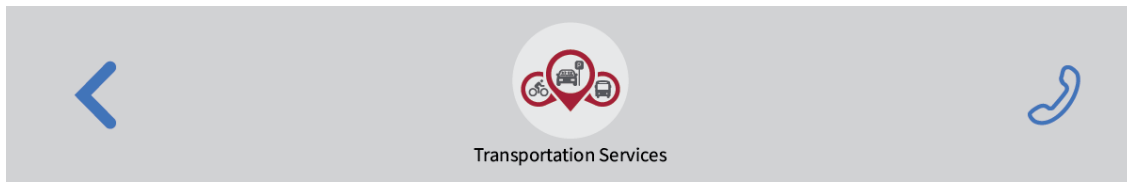
