The Evening Parking Shuttle (EPS) now serves the Palo Alto Transit Center, to support staff who would like to utilize alternative transportation options such as Caltrain.

The Evening Parking Shuttle (EPS) service is a free service designed to transport hospital staff on demand from the 500 Pasteur Transportation Lounge and Lucile Packard Children's Hospital Main Lobby to different parking locations around campus between 9:00 p.m. – 4:00 a.m. Hospital Transportation Services provides this service for Swing and Night shift hospital workers, whose shifts may end outside of regular shuttle service hours.
