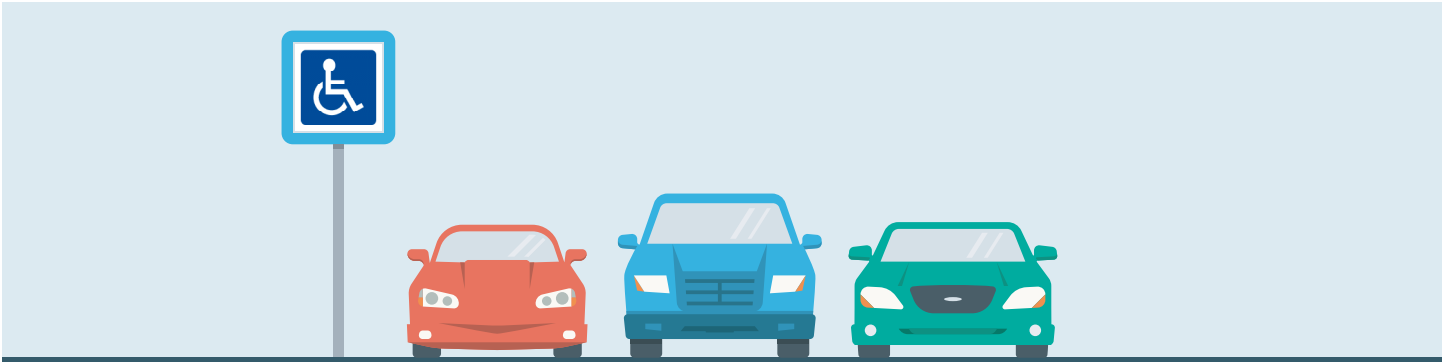


ACCESSIBLE PARKING FOR STAFF



Staff with a state-issued disability placard should refer to the following information when looking for where to park:



California vehicle code regulations for vehicles with accessible placards are valid on public streets and other municipal lots. Stanford Medicine lots and garages are privately owned and are therefore not governed by the CVC codes in section 225115.

Stanford University Lots and Garages

Accessible parking spaces are available in many Stanford University lots and garages. Individuals with state-issued disability parking placards (from any state) can park in any marked space in university lots and garages.

This Includes:

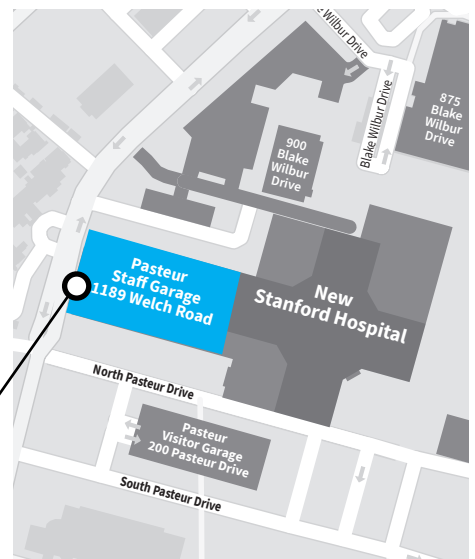
- Designated blue disabled-access spaces
- Commuter ('A', 'C', Hoover Garage' etc.) and residential permit spaces ('ES', 'EA', etc.)
- Visitor pay parking spaces

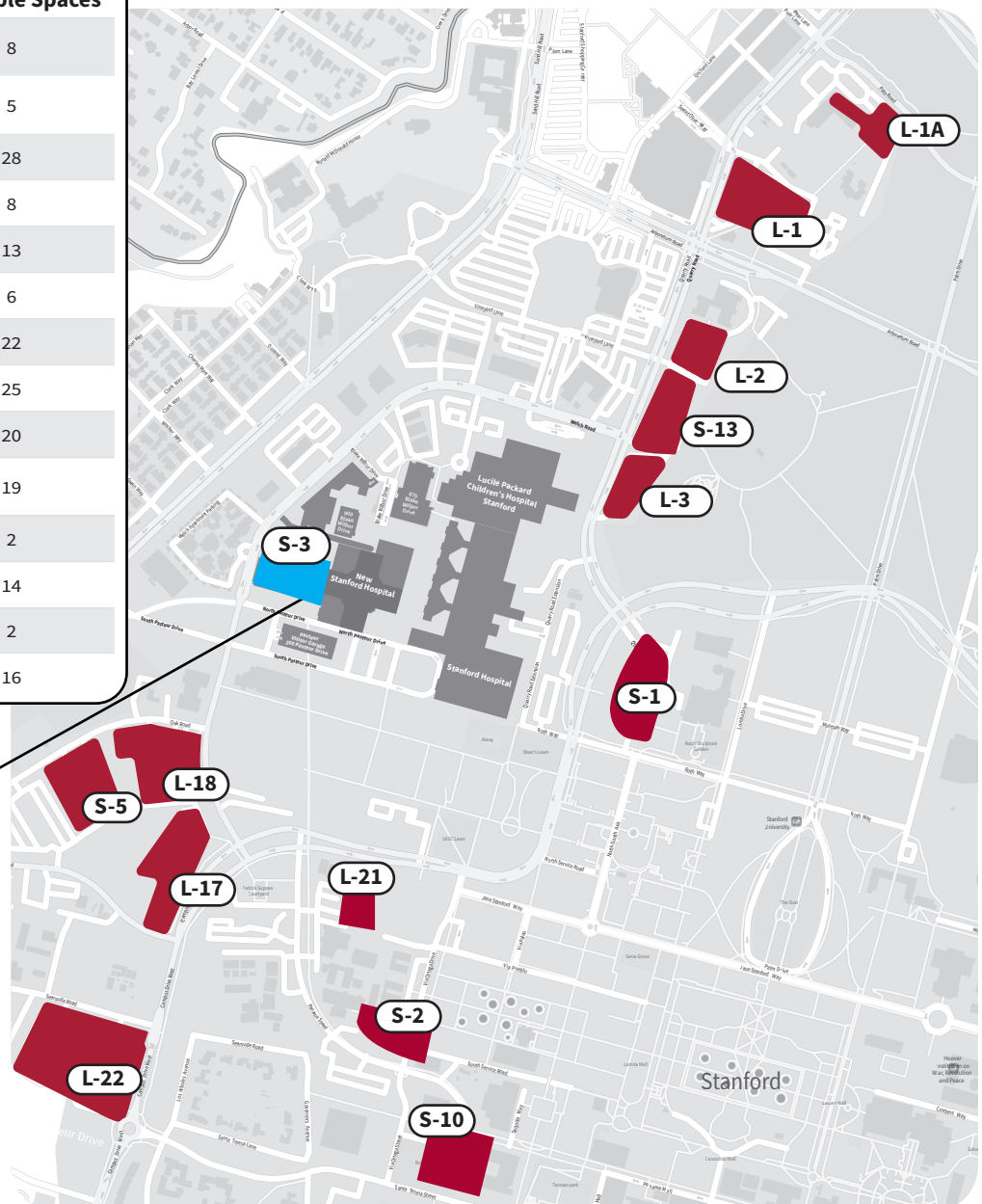


ACCESSIBLE PARKING FOR STAFF

Pasteur Staff Garage requires a \$16 daily permit.

All Stanford University Lots and Garages: Any state-issued disability parking placard or plate is considered valid in any disabled, commuter, residential, metered or visitor parking space in Stanford University lots and garages. Payment and observation of time limits is required in some locations as posted.
