

# Parking for Hospital Construction Workers

All hospital construction parking is at the Stanford Mall Parking Garage Rooftop

Construction worker parking is allowed only at the designated rooftop parking area in the Stanford Mall, using a valid Stanford Mall Construction Permit.

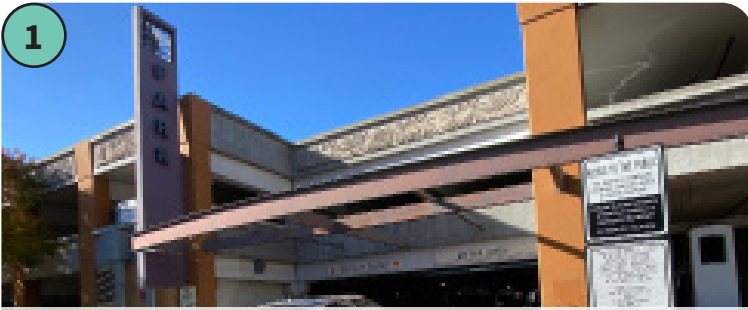
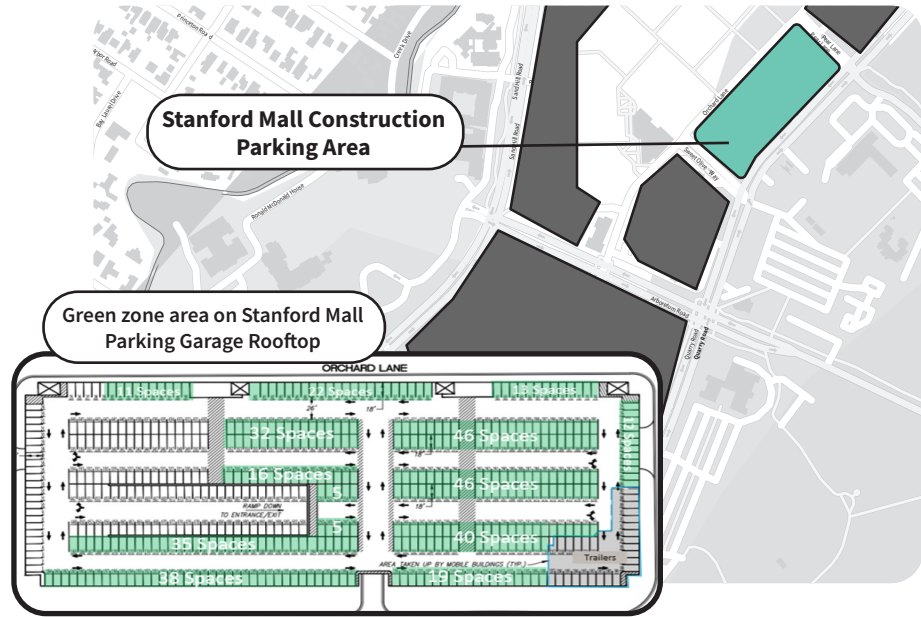
## Parking at the Stanford Mall

### Construction worker parking is allowed:

- ✓ In the green zone area on the rooftop level of the garage indicated on the map

### Construction workers may not park in:

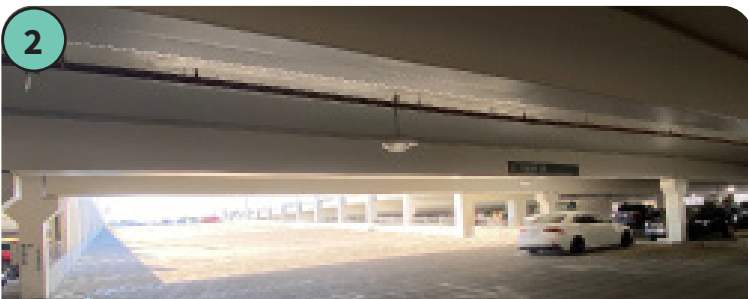
- ✗ Other areas of the Stanford Shopping Center
- ✗ Hospital patient & visitor parking areas, including Lucile Packard Children's Hospital Main and West Garages, Blake Wilbur Lot, and the Pasteur Visitor Garage
- ✗ 500P - Pasteur Staff Garage



1 Enter the Garage via Quarry Road



3 Park within the green zone area on the rooftop with your Stanford Mall Rooftop Parking Permit (indicated by green signage above)



2 Drive up the ramp to the rooftop level
